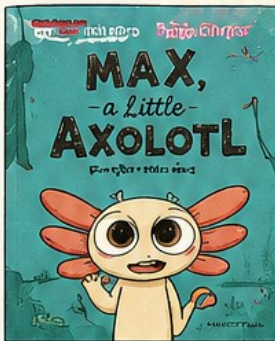

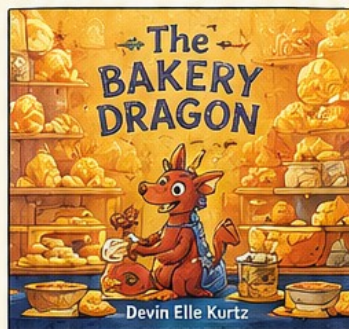

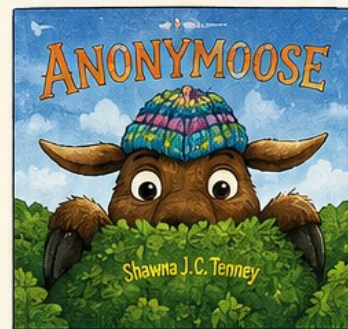
★ FEATURED BOOKS ★
